ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS



Aluminium: Cans, Foil, Extrusions, Siding and Gutters, Ladders, Automotive radiators and castings, HVAC Copper-Aluminum radiators, Automotive rims, Machine shop turnings

Copper: Copper tubing, bare wire, cookware, roofing copper

Insulated Wire: Copper or Aluminium wires and cables with insulated coatings. ROMEX, THHN, MCM, #1 Insulated, #2 Insulated, Aluminium Insulated, Steel BX, Aluminium BX, Communication/Networking wire, Lead-Coated Copper wire

Brass & Bronze: Yellow brass, Red Brass, Brass bullet casings, Bronze gears and castings, Brass machine shop turnings

Stainless Steel: Stainless steel sinks, Stainless steel hardware, Stainless Steel machine shop turnings

Lead: Hard and soft lead, Wheel weights, Lead-coated copper

Batteries: Lead acid batteries, Steel-cased lead acid batteries, Laptop Li-Ion batteries, Power tool batteries, Cell phone batteries

Electronic Scrap: Computers, Laptops, Servers, Circuit boards, Hard drives, Power Supplies, Disk Drives, Cell Phones

Nickel & High-temp: Nickel, Monel, Tungsten, Inconel, & Titanium solids and machine shop turnings

Iron & Steel: Light gauge steel, Tin, Heavy iron, I-beam, Plate, Old scrap machinery

Household Appliances: Refrigerators (accepted, but only paid for without refrigerant), washers, dryers, microwaves, dishwashers, and water heaters.



Vehicles: We only accept vehicles with a signed and notarized title.

We do not provide towing services.

- 2.** Your signature for each transaction.
- 3.** The date and time of your transaction.
- 4.** A description of the scrap material included in the transaction, including the weight of the scrap material and the amount paid to you.

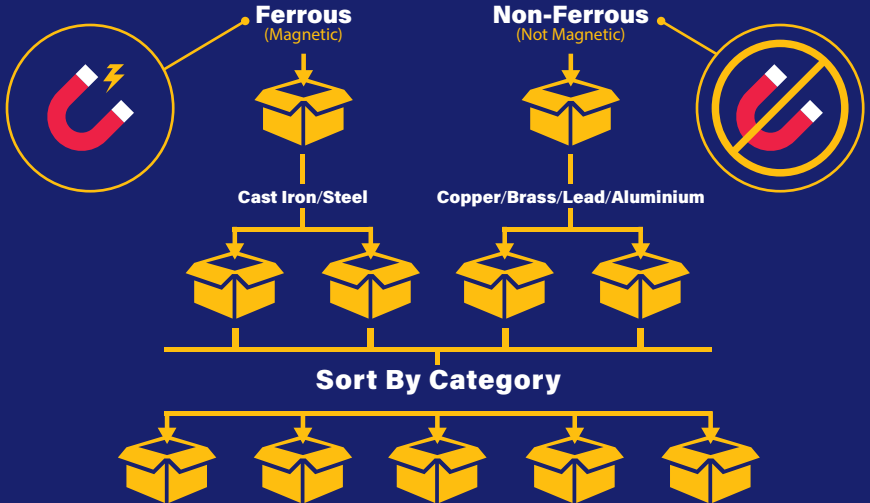

HOW TO SORT YOUR METAL

Follow these steps to get the most for your metal.



CODE OF CONDUCT

Visiting a scrap yard for the first time can seem intimidating, but here at Sullivan's we want to make your visit as simple, and safe, as possible. Here are a few guidelines to keep in mind when coming to visit one of our locations:

1. **NO** open toed shoes are permitted in the yard
2. Smoking is **NOT** permitted at any of our facilities
3. You do not need to visit the office. All transactions will take place in the yard and ATM building.
4. If you are a new customer have a valid ID ready. All returning customers have your ID key fob ready
5. Please keep animals and young children in your vehicle. Safety is priority number one for everyone in the yard.
6. Do not unload or park your trailer on the street. All drop offs only occur within our yard.
7. All payment transactions take place in our ATM building. Take your ticket to the ATM, scan your bar code, and receive your payment.
8. Be aware of your surroundings. Machine operators have limited vision, do not assume they can see you.
9. Disassembling, or "picking" through the scrap piles is not permitted.
